### **2. Approval of Minutes – May 18, 2012**

### **3. Phase I Reconnaissance Plan for the Lower Long Island Sound Drainage Basin**

Chuck Strome reviewed the contract with Malcolm Pirnie/ARCADIS for the completion of Phase I of the Reconnaissance Plan. The scope of work includes the collection of data from each municipality and the Westchester County Department of Planning needed to complete the Reconnaissance Plan. This shall include a detailed watershed map, an inventory of areas prone to stormwater and flooding problems, a list of stormwater and flood control projects being considered by each municipality and copies of any relevant studies, ordinances and stormwater management plans from each municipality.

Malcolm Pirnie/ARCADIS will create a list of projects for funding and identify opportunities for intermunicipal projects and agreements. They will also recommend any rules, regulations and legislation for the management of stormwater and operation of facilities. LISWIC members will be asked to provide copies of their Hazard Mitigation Plans, resolutions or agreements of cooperation with other municipalities in the watershed, any existing mapping or information on stormwater infrastructure and management practices and any comments or amendments to FEMA flood maps, hydrological maps or topographic maps.

A sample resolution was distributed to all present that authorizes each municipality to participate and share the costs of the preparation of Phase II of the Reconnaissance Plan. LISWIC members were asked to have this resolution adopted by their local governing boards. Phase I of the Reconnaissance Plan should be completed within one month. Malcolm Pirnie will be invited to present their work to LISWIC. Phase II should take a couple of months to complete.
